

# **GEVA JUNIOR TOURNAMENT WARM UP PROCEDURE**

Captains' conference/coin flip at 8:45 am.

Warm up ends at 8:58.

9:00 am, start the first set, or forfeit. \*\*\*

9:10 am, second set forfeit.

All GEVA Junior pre-match warm-ups will be as follows:

2 minutes together with each team on their own side of the court.

4 minutes exclusive use of the court for the serving team.

4 minutes exclusive use of the court for the receiving team.

As soon as one match is completed, the official will get down from the stand, walk to the other side of the court, start his/her clock and call for the captains. The captains' conference is conducted during the two minutes of shared court time.

If one team captain is not present 15 seconds prior to the start of the first four minute warm-up period, allow the captain that is there to make their choice of serve/receive/side with the consequent use of the court. If neither captain is present at least 15 seconds prior to the end of the 2 minute shared time, the serve will be assigned to the team listed first on the schedule and will be assigned to the side of the court on the scorekeeper's left.

If neither team is present, but one or both appear before the conclusion of warm-ups, the time remaining in the warm up period may be divided in half for use of the teams as appropriate.

A team(s) forfeits if they are not present, AND READY TO PLAY, at the scheduled set start time. Team delay procedures for teams that have not submitted their line-up two minutes before the beginning of the match will be applied.

Before a forfeit can be declared the team present must have submitted a line-up, appear in uniform and line up on the end line at set time.

Complete Work Teams that do not appear for their assignment 5 minutes before the start of a match will be assessed a one point per minute penalty on the first game of their next match. This must be recorded in the comments section of the scoresheet.

Complete work teams include, a Second Referee, a Scorekeeper, an Assistant Scorekeeper, two Lines Judges and responsible supervision.

\*\*\* The Tournament Director may rearrange the teams in the pool if one team is missing, and if work personnel is available, but this must be done in a timely enough fashion to allow an on time start.
