

FAQ for Classroom Clinic:

Where can I find complete details on becoming a GEVA referee before attending this clinic?

The online clinic contains all the information you need to know. You can also find this information at www.GEVA.org

Do I have to be a GEVA member to attend the clinic?

No, not to attend the clinic, but yes to pursue a rating.

Can I register for the Region at the clinic?

No, this is done online at www.GEVA.org/Registration.

How much does the clinic cost?

Free. If you can find a cheaper clinic elsewhere, take it.

What if I don't complete the online clinic?

This is a requirement for certification. This online resource allows us to cut classroom time and travel requirement other training opportunities require.

When will I have to take the test?

Anytime after you complete the classroom session and before your practical evaluation.

How long will the classroom clinic take?

Plan on 5 hours, straight through, bring a snack.

What should I bring?

A pen is about the only physical thing needed. Do bring questions from the online presentation.

Do I need a uniform for this session?

This is strictly a classroom discussion session. Practical evaluation comes later.
